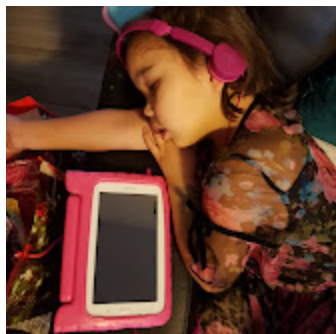
Christmas was busy. I was sick for the bulk of it I am afraid. But the girls had fun. Attached are a few highlights :)

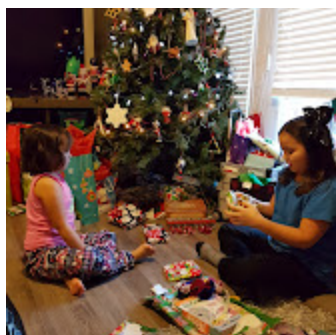

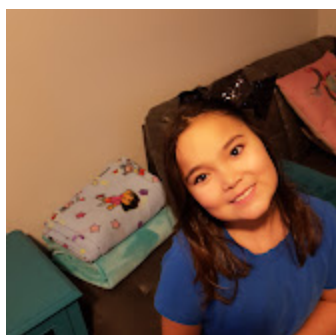
