Dear Mr. Apsie,

I wrote to you a few weeks back - in answer to a letter from you asking me about accommodation etc. and rates I may have to offer.

I replied quoting you certain rates - on the advice of a friend who had been taking in paying guests for many years - but since then, I have been going into the whole thing more thoroughly and have come to the conclusion that the rates I quoted ^{on the advice of this person} is a bit on the high side - ^{for the country} so I have decided to modify the rates, and have decided to write to let you know this, - for I have reduced them somewhat. They are now:-

Large (very large) bedroom with shower etc. }	\$30.00 U.S.
for 2 people per day (for the room) }	20.00 U.S.
" 1 person " " for the room }	
Other double bedroom without bath etc. }	25.00 U.S.
for 2 people per day (for the room) }	18.00 U.S.
" 1 person " " " " }	

There are 2 single rooms without bath }
each per person per day will be 16.00 U.S.

Three meals will be provided - breakfast, lunch and dinner which will be included. Afternoon tea can be had for an extra 75¢ B.W.I.

I am prepared to meet you at the airport - and bring you here - and even drive you around a bit - though self-drive cars are obtainable at \$15.00 B.W.I.

per day. My charges will include service charge and the use of the telephone exclusive of overseas calls - and I am prepared to offer a couple of drinks before lunch and before dinner though it is advisable that the guests provide their own liquor - which will make it easier for me - so that I don't have to take out a liquor licence.

The rates quoted are the normal rates, but you suggested that there were several of you as families who have bought lots at Mt Alexander - and if several of you come down - and there are repeat bookings I am willing to make a special arrangement for you all at a reduced rate.

Would you kindly let me know at your earliest convenience if you and your friends are interested. I would like to have you all and make you as comfortable and satisfied as possible - so let me know what are your ideas and plans.
