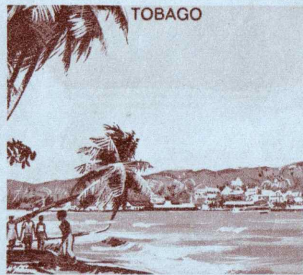

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Trinidad

Thursday 20th Aug. 1970

Dear Mr. Ayer,

How nice to hear from you again and to learn that you still plan to return to Grenada. Thanks for your letter ~~of~~ received last week in which you asked if I will be able to accommodate you from 7th - 20th February 1970.

Yes, I'll have a double room available - a very large room (something like 15 ft x 20 ft) with its own bath etc. which you can have. I have another available but that one has not got its own bathroom and the occupants of that room have to use the family bathroom. The charge for the first one mentioned is \$30.00 per couple per day - ~~but these~~ whilst the charge for the other room with out the bathroom is \$25.00. All charges are in U.S. currency and include all meals to suit the guests (even coffee or tea in bed in the morning) all drinks, laundry and service charge. I will also meet you at the airport and take you there when leaving.

I can arrange for you to have a "self-drive" car (these are about \$50.00 U.S. per week) - but they are only obtainable in St. George's - so I can arrange for one to be sent up to Sauteurs for you - or I can take you into St. George's the day or day after your arrival to pick one up there - just let me know what you wish done!

I came to Trinidad on Sunday for a short-
vacation, but was so tired I fell asleep at the
wheel going to the airport & crashed into a tele-
phone post. However - even though injured I was
determined to get to the airport & to get on that
plane. I made it - and how ??? I was in such
pain & of course suffering from shock - so
"passed out" completely at Piarco airport on my
arrival in Trinidad. So here I am confined
to bed - am staying with my sister & her family.
I have a rather badly injured right leg so can-
not walk - but should be able to do so by
next week. I'll be returning to Grenada early
in September. Looking forward to hearing from
you soon.
