So that is the main reason why things don't go as fast as I would like. I he ve not moved yet to Mt. Alexander because the machinery is not quite ready as I'm expecting a few more spare parts from USA and I hope to have everything ready very soon. At the moment also we have very he avy rains but in few more days they will be over. Believe me Mr. Bra seeur I'm the most interested to finish the Development as soon as possible. Dr. Guillis House is almost finish and his family will most to the house in a few more days, they are now painting the house, the Contractor was Mr. Williamson and he charged 25.00 WI per sq. ft. apparently they are very pleased with him.

I had not the time to study your suggestion about selling land and house together. I personally are not able to finance the houses, so I have to get in touch with the Banks here and explore the feasebility and posibilities for it, by the way just last week they have opened The Chase Manhattan Bank. In any case I hope something can be done concerning this matter. Also I have to study your suggestion of special treatament concessions for all the Air Canada buyers so as soon as have though about it I will inform you.
